LOOKING FOR JESUS

TEACHING

In our world we are beset by many significant challenges and dangers. Trials and temptations cause our faith to falter and even fail. We live in a world where the attitude is of self first. An attitude that is a toxic, pervasive mindset that completely impacts all of our behaviour.

QUESTIONS

What parts of your world are hurting now and in need of Jesus to enter into?

LOOKING AT JESUS

TEACHING

Paul describes – in verses 6-11 – the glory of Jesus on earth and in heaven. His authority and His responsibility. Paul encourages the church to seek out even the remnants of the unity that we have in Christ. If any – encouragement or tenderness or compassion or sharing of the Spirit etc. then to be grateful for that power that is at work within you.

QUESTIONS

What aspects of who Jesus is resonates most with you?

What aspects of what Jesus has done resonates most with you?

How does your gratitude for who God is and what God has done live out through you?

LOOKING LIKE JESUS

TEACHING

The Heidelberg Catechism challenges our response to be *wholeheartedly willing and ready from now on to live for Him*. Gratitude of how our lives have been impacted by Jesus is a good thing. It calls and compels us into a response. A response of serving but not a serving for our benefit or even the benefit of those we are serving. Rather the benefit is for God's own glory as His kingdom is built by our responses of obedience and faith.

QUESTIONS

How much of your life could be described as whole heartedly willing and ready to live for Jesus?

Where in your life are you serving God – for His glory and His purposes?
