TEACHING

GIFT OF POWER

TEACHING

TEACHING

God's revelation in the miracles was seen as impossible by the crowd around them. Peter's message went to the heart of the covenant history, the Jesus present and into the future of the believers.

REFLECTIONS

What part of God's gospel message is the greatest for you to believe?

GIFT OF PERMISSION

TEACHING

The crowd responds to Peter's message in faith and in hope. We too are given the opportunity to respond in faith – or not. To protect ourselves from too much God rather than giving God permission to enter into all aspects of our lives.
