## **SEEKING**

### *TEACHING*

In the midst of chaos in our world the church has traditionally been a strength of source and comfort. Yet the church has not been immune to the changes and challenges. For some what used to be the core of our faith and our lives has become cluttered and chaotic in the midst of a turbulent world.

### *REFLECTIONS*

What is cluttering your faith life from having a firm foundation?

What do you need to declutter to create space for God to be more in your life?

## **SACRED**

### *TEACHING*

A monument represents a person or an event. The church building can be a sanctuary – a sacred place to connect with God. But not all see the presence of God within the building or it's works.

### *REFLECTIONS*

Where has the church succeeded – or failed – at being a representative of God?

Where do you schedule your sacred moments with God?

Where has God shown up unexpectedly with sacred moments?

## **STORY**

### *TEACHING*

Isaiah 6 is a context where speaks and engages Isaiah. Isaiah responds to God's call for confession and obedience. Louis Giglio in a book entitled The Air I Breathe summarizes *Worship as a response (all we are and do) to God (for all He is and all He's done)*

### *REFLECTION*

What value or worth do you offer to God in your worship?

How and where do you worship outside of church on a Sunday morning?
