A way station also replenishes what we need in order to best move forward in life. The disciples determined – through prayer and the scriptures that they needed to replace Judas.

REFLECTIONS

Where in your life has prayer been answered by God?

Where is God calling you to grow so that you can be better prepared for whatever is next for you?
