COMMENDATION

TEACHING

Jesus' letter to the church in Ephesus affirmed good things about who the people were and how they were living. Despite the hardships of persecution they continued to be diligent about what they believed and determined to how they lived it out.

REFLECTIONS

CALLING

TEACHING

Jesus does not leave the church – in Ephesus or today – in this place of condemnation though. He calls it to remember where it has drifted away and then to repent and then to return to His calling of love. In that place we will find a reward of connecting with Jesus fully and abundantly.

REFLECTIONS

Where in your life can Jesus take a greater priority – focus – passion?
