TEACHING

The church in Laodocia was filled with images that Christ used to challenge its perception of who it was and how it lived. The city – and the church – was self sufficient with riches, fashion, importance and health and yet they were unable to provide adequate drinking water. The imported water that started hot became lukewarm and the water that started cool became tepid.
